If you or someone you care about has Medicare, make sure you mark your calendars. Medicare Open Enrollment is earlier this year. It starts on **October 15th and ends on December 7th**. Use this opportunity to review your Medicare choices and make sure you have the plan that is right for you. You may be able to save money, get better coverage or both. The Oregon Senior Health Insurance Benefits Assistance (SHIBA) Program is a federally funded program available to assist Oregon Medicare beneficiaries.
